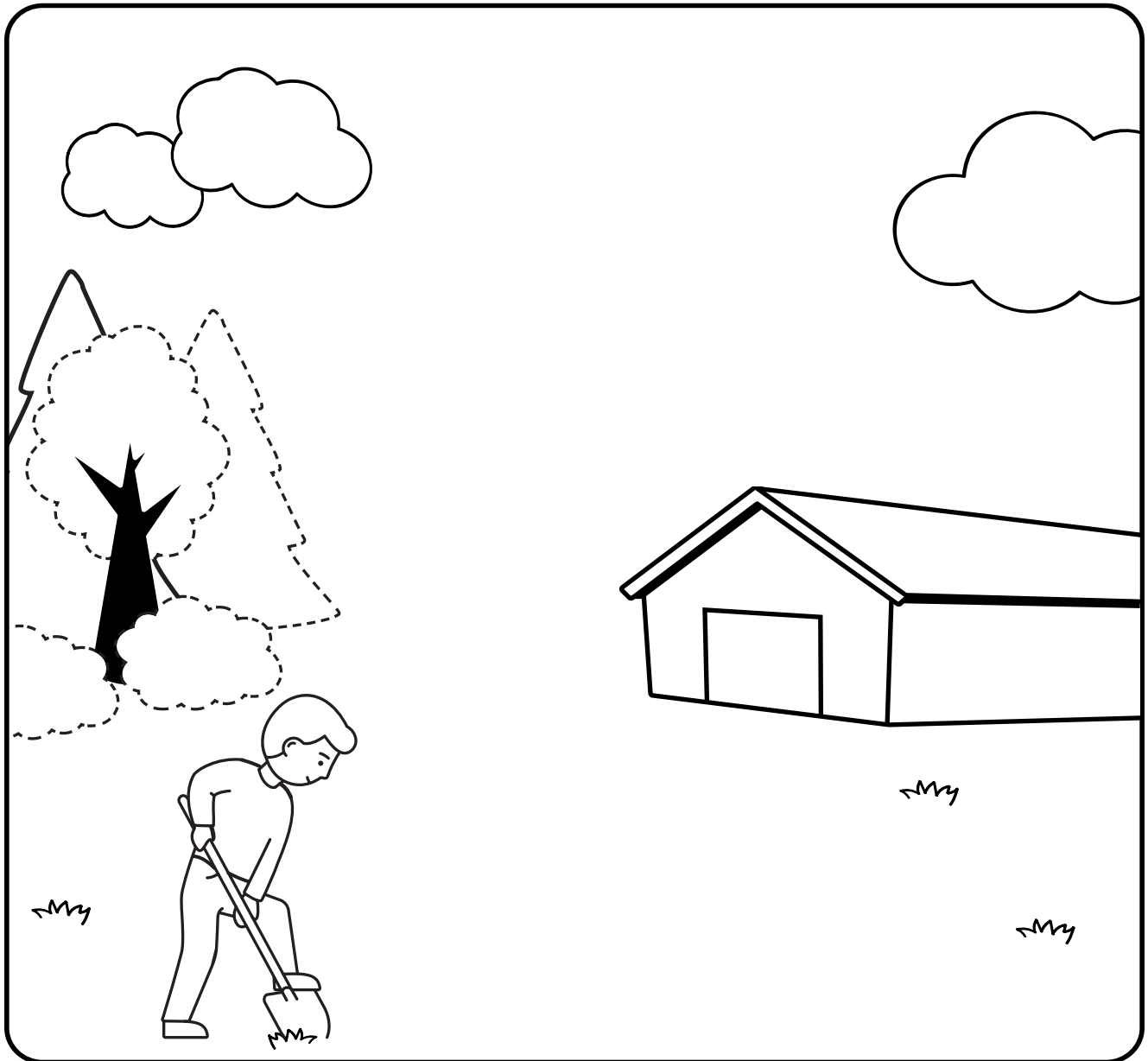


GIVE ME SHELTER!

Planting two or more rows of trees and shrubs on a farm site creates a windbreak, improves air quality and preserves wildlife habitats. These staggered rows of trees and shrubs is called a shelterbelt.
